### **Camp of Basics -Learning from the Patriarchs**

If you are a teenager, US Citizen and not accepted as a Summer team member for Germany, you may register even with 14-15 years old. (The German Campers will be 15-23 years of age).

For early registrations till March 2008 you pay € 275,- (\$ 400,- including 2 extra days, cost of daytrip to the city of Kassel, and travel twice to the airport./ 500 km); You will arrive August 6<sup>th</sup> at Frankfurt Airport, one day before Camp starts; and return home after the Camp, August 17<sup>th</sup> from Frankfurt Airport. Let your parents arrange your air flight / ticket and send us a registration fee of \$ 50,- which will be subtracted from your total cost with your final pay.

If you also want to take the German Tour you need to add approximately \$ 270,- . Then you need to pay a combined application fee of \$ 200,- which will be subtracted from your total cost of \$ 675,-. If the Dollar is getting better you have to pay less at the end.

In both cases you need the signature of your parents on the Application Form. You also need to agree to submit to the Camp Rules and / or Tour Rules. You also need the written permission of your parents to go swimming and canoeing (with life vest).

Don't forget your valid passport!

When you arrive it is expected that you mix with German teenagers at Camp, speak English with them, and you will be assigned to sleep with the Germans in a room. We do not allow girls in boys dorms, nor boys in girls dorms. Smoking is not permitted on the Camp grounds.
