1. Land Purchased for Nuwakot (Jeevanmarg Church) and temporary building built



Nazarene Church could buy a piece of land for the Daughter Church in North West part of Nepal. It is very important because the

house owner was forced to leave the place where the members previously met.

We built a temporary building for church fellowship. Now the local members are really excited for the building for fellowship. There are more than 90 members. Through the church, we are reaching out to the unreached people of that community.

2. Jabez Training School Re-opening

After the winter break, Jabez is re-opened for the new academic session with the enrollment of the new students from different A.C.N Churches in and outside Kathmandu. We praise God for the wonderful plan in preparing and equipping the young men and women for the plentiful harvest in the world.

3. Baptism

As the sign of the growth of Church, 5 members were baptized in Nazarene Church on 25th of February. The Lord is adding more souls through the preaching of the word and through

making disciples. We praise God for the wonderful blessing of adding more into His kingdom. 13 were baptized in Jeevanmarg Church in Nuwakot.



4. Teaching on Formation of Diocese

On 3rd March, 30 participants (including Standing Committee members) from different A.C.N Churches in Kathmandu came together for the teaching on Formation of a Diocese by Rev. Canon Kuan Kim Seng. During the teaching, he emphasized making disciples of Jesus by fulfilling the great commission given by our Lord Jesus Christ before he ascended into heaven. Revd. Kuan Kim Seng highlighted to have the formation of Diocese these are to be noted:

1. 100 Confirmed members in each of at least 6 parishes
2. Regular Tithing
3. Self Financing (Supporting their own Pastor)
4. Possibly having own building

The teaching mainly focused to form our diocese within very short time according to how effectively we will continue to work. This is the challenge for the Churches to achieve and fulfill the role.

5. Visiting A.C.N Churches outside Kathmandu with Rev. Canon Bill and Ps. Chew Boon Ann



It was wonderful visiting outside Kathmandu to see the churches of Anglican with Canon Bill,

Ps. Chew Boon along with Standing Committee members on 6th and 7th March. We were blessed to have and see the extended church planting of Nazarene in Nuwakot where Nazarene managed to buy a piece of land. About 30-35 members were waiting for us for the warm fellowship in the temporary place.



We had warm fellowship with Pastors from Dhading District where the A.C.N's majority of the churches are. We visited the land site where we got the land.

6. God miraculously saved

On 19th March, one of the young leaders Amos, his wife and his niece met with a road accident as they were traveling back to their home were hit by a drunkard driver. God miraculously saved them and Amos' wife was a bit hurt and was admitted in the hospital as she was on the final months for delivering a child.

7. Meeting at National Level and Prayer Chain Demonstration for the Burial place

that represents all the Christians of Nepal for their rights, have been talking and organizing the Press Conference for the need of a Burial place for

last 3 years and the Government is not addressing the need of the Christians.



So from 23rd March 2011, the New Constitution Christian Advisory Committee has announced prayer chain demonstrations in 63 districts to draw the attention of

the Government. The peaceful demonstrations will continue until the Government provides a specific place for Christian Burials.

The Human Rights, almost all the Political parties, all the religious groups have expressed their solidarity to what Christians have been demanding.

8. Church Dedication

On 23rd March, Ps. Norpu Lama and Ps. Bikash Shrestha dedicated the church in Slum area which was started at the initiation of Nazarene Church. It was really the blessed occasion to thank God for His faithfulness to what He has done.



This church is handed over to the local leadership under the leadership of Brother Daniel Pun.

Presently there are more than 350 members.
