after our English Camp in August we hosted several Groups at Knüll Camp. During the Music-Camp almost every spot at our Camp site was filled either with cars, vans, trailers or tents. 230 people lived on the

grounds and 80 in our two guest houses. This Music-Camp went on for 8 days and offered about 50 different work shops from harp over trumpet to drums. Because of many non Christian participants we had the chance to build up Christian friendship and witness to many of them.

All 130 kids slept in tents, the 40 adult helpers and leader in the main building. It was a terrific 10 day camp. It rained almost every day - there was mud all over. We also had a reunion at KnuellCamp with some of the older folks from her time of ministry. Soon after that we took her together with Sue Brodish to Switzerland to participate at a week long Global Outreach Conference. (Grace's parents served under Global Outreach Mission for more than 40 years)

Pray for Rev. Winkler who is preparing a church planting work in Hamburg.



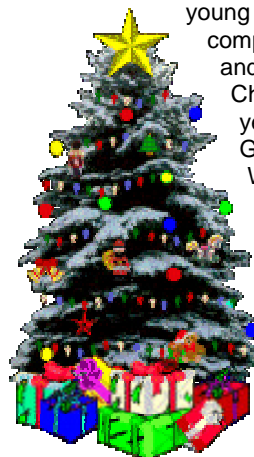
Beginning with the Advent season we distributed on first Advent weekend Christian Literature at the Market place in Schwarzenborn and during the second Advent
