

CUBA MISSIONS SUPPORT NEEDED FOR 2012

Once again, we are at that time of year to begin our preparations for the Annual Missions Trip to Cuba. We have already received about 1/3rd of the funds that are required to support the work there. We are making this appeal for the balance.

FINANCES - We cover all of the Pastors' salaries, as well as all of the costs of operating:

- 7 established churches,
- 10 church plant/house churches with over 750 people
- Seminary courses for both the Clergy and Lay Readers
- Sunday School supplies
- Bibles
- Benches and chairs for the churches

Our Mission stretches from Moa in the Western end of the country, to Pinar del Rio in the Eastern end. That is a distance of about 1500 kilometres. Our Clergy and Lay Readers are doing a wonderful job evangelizing the country for Jesus Christ. However, they need your support to be able to continue this work. We support 6 Pastors and 6 Lay Readers, as well as their families. How can you help???

men's socks and sleeveless undershirts;
boy's t-shirts and shorts sizes 8, 10, and 12;
Wedding rings
Crosses for the clergy to wear
used and working cell phones;
vitamins for adults and children;
diabetic and asthma supplies;
bicycle tire tubes sizes 26 3/8 and 27 1/4;
foot cream for diabetic feet.

We are able to purchase some of these items here in Canada and carry them with us in our suitcases. Some other items we have to purchase in Cuba. What is the Lord asking you to give???
